

FFL Transfer Policy

You must be a resident of Illinois with a valid FOID card.

You must comply with all age restrictions of Federal, State and Local law.

You must abide by the Illinois Waiting Period before taking possession of the firearm. 24 hours for a long gun; 72 hours for a hand gun.

RKA Gun Gallery requires a copy of proof of purchase with your name and date from the seller.

We cannot sell or transfer handguns that are known to fail Illinois state law. If a firearm is sent to our shop for transfer, these will need to be sent back to the seller.

RKA Gun Gallery accepts transfers from individuals as well as licensed dealers. If transferring in a gun from an individual rather than a dealer, please ask the shipper to include a photocopy of their driver's license in the shipment, as well as your name and contact information.

All transfers must be processed into our system before being transferred out. Depending on the number of shipments arriving on a given day or the time of day it is delivered, this process can take several hours.

We will contact you once your transfer is ready.

RKA Gun Gallery has the right to refuse transfer for any reason. We are prevented by law from transferring to individuals who are, or who appear to be, intoxicated. We are very sensitive to anything resembling a "straw purchase" and will refuse a transfer if the name of the buyer and the person picking up the firearm are not the same person; this includes husbands and wives. Cost for a firearm transfer is \$40/per firearm.
